



Confirmation Requirements

Our Confirmation program is a 3-year program, beginning in 6th grade and completion in 8th grade. The following is required of students preparing for the Sacrament of Confirmation:

- At least two consecutive years of prior faith formation before receiving the sacrament, either in a Catholic school or a parish religious education program
- Have received the Sacraments of Baptism, Reconciliation, and Eucharist
- Regular attendance at weekend Mass (*If you go to another church for Mass, please bring their bulletin, signed by the priest, to be turned into the Faith Formation office with your name on it.*)
- Regular attendance at Faith Formation classes
 - 6th—Learn about God, Jesus, the Church, Sacraments, and Morality in the Old Testament
 - 7th—Learn about Jesus Christ and His Life in the New Testament
 - 8th—Learn about the Church; its History & Doctrine, and the Sacrament of Confirmation*
- Complete community service as outlined in the 6th, 7th, & 8th grade requirements

These additional requirements are for eighth grade only:

- Parent/Student Meeting
- Nine sacrament classes*, incorporated into the regular class time chosen
- Attend Sponsor & Confirmandi Session with Rev. Terry Deffenbaugh O.S.A.
- Attend Confirmation Retreat with Rev. Terry Deffenbaugh O.S.A.
- Interview with Mrs. Watroba
- Complete & turn in required documents (received at Parent/Student Meeting)
- Confirmation Practice
- Sacrament of Confirmation—celebrated on a weeknight in the second semester of 8th grade (usually in May)
